We are pleased to present this unique opportunity to combine a fabulous 7-night cruise exploring Assam in North East India on a cruise on the custom-built MV Mahabaahu with a 6-night tour of the Golden Triangle visiting most popular cultural gems in historic Delhi, Agra, the Taj Mahal and the imposing capital of Rajasthan, Jaipur. We also stay for one night at the Dera Village Retreat, offering the chance to discover villages in the Aravalli Hills, home to the Meena Tribal people.

Please note this programme is not suitable for anyone with walking difficulties.

Cruise Price Includes: Entrance fees, port dues, govt tax, portage, guide services (English language), main meals, jugged coffee and selection of teas and tisanes, mineral water. Transfers between ports of embarkation and Jorhat and Guwahati Airports at the start and end of the voyage. **Land Section Includes:** Accommodation on a twin sharing basis including breakfast, all transfers and transportation, all entrances fees, battery bus ride in Agra, govt service taxes, English speaking guides on each city, 2 bottles of mineral water per day, all taxes, assistance and portage at airports.

Price Excludes: International flights, laundry, all visa costs, drinks, fuel surcharges (see terms and conditions), espressos and cappuccinos at bar, tipping.

Please Note: Drinks and crew gratuities are NOT included on our partner cruises. We suggest to change money at a bank at the international airport before exiting (currently there is shortage of new money bills in India).

Luggage Limit on Internal Flights: Within India: 15 kg per check-in luggage and 7 kg for hand luggage. Excess charge for check-in luggage is approximately INR 300.- (USD 5.-) per kg.

UPSTREAM ITINERARY

River Conditions Warning!

The rivers you will sail on are subject to seasonal rises and falls of water level, in some places as much as 30 metres. Water levels can change dramatically overnight and a sudden rise can impede our progress upstream considerably and even prevent us from passing under certain bridges. A sudden fall can result in our being unable to get into certain places or go as far upstream as we would hope. Groundings on sandbars are not infrequent and are part of the excitement of any Pandaw expedition. Published itineraries are indicational only and subject to sudden change. In such events alternative itineraries will be provided and we do our best to ensure that if a stop is missed we make up for it with another stop. Passengers are thus forewarned and expected to be flexible and patient. River cruising in Asia can be a dramatic and adventurous experience - not like cruising the controlled waterways of Europe or America. Note also that we operate in areas with little or no developed infrastructure and subject to the strictures of local officialdom. Be prepared for this and it is all more the fun!
